

Volunteering at Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary

Thank you for your interest in volunteering at Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary! To help our sanctuary grow and to give the best possible care to our farm animal residents, we have started to recruit a limited number volunteers and this will expand to a range of volunteer positions over the next few years. There is a lot of work involved in running a farm sanctuary from taking care of the animals, to farm property maintenance and improvements, to all the administrative, fundraising, and community outreach events and activities that go on behind the scenes, and we need your help. We would love for you to help us out and over time there will be a range of volunteer work options to choose from. We are truly appreciative of any assistance you can offer!

The minimum requirements to be a volunteer at Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary includes:

- -To have an interest in helping farm animals and supporting the mission, values, and goals of Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary
- -Be 19 years of age or older (minors are welcome to volunteer with a parental/guardian volunteer)
- -Be willing to sign a Liability Waiver, Confidentiality Agreement, and Volunteer Agreement that outline the volunteer policies and procedures.

Volunteers of Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary can be divided into the following categories:

One-Time Volunteers: This is an option for people who are interested in volunteering once at Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary without making any further commitment. It is an ideal way for people who have little or no prior experience with farm animals or being on a farm, but are interested in farm animal welfare and would like to try out a shift. This option is also more suitable for people who cannot commit to volunteering on a regular basis. It is also a great option for a team building day and for organizations/businesses who want to offer a community service project to their members/employees. One-time opportunities include helping with the animal care, farm maintenance and operations (e.g., spring or fall clean-up), and community events or fundraisers. These shifts vary from 2 to 6 hours depending on the volunteer project or activity. Training and instructions will be provided either on the day of service, or in advance depending on the complexity of the duties.

Regular Volunteers: This option available to people who would like to commit to volunteering on a more regular basis. Several positions (both on-site and remote) will be available in different areas and many will require special requirements, qualifications, and training. They will be posted publicly on social media and the sanctuary web site when there are new openings. The following is a list of our current volunteer positions:

• Animal Care Program – Regular or one-time volunteers

- Administrative Assistant Remote position
- Farm Hand Regular or one-time volunteers
- Habitat and Grassland Restoration Volunteer Regular and one-time volunteers
- Humane Educator Remote and on-site
- Compassion Camp Counsellors summer on-site
- Community Outreach and Fundraising Assistants For Special Events Remote and on-site

If you are interested in volunteering at Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary, please fill out the attached confidential <u>Volunteer Interest and Application Form</u>, and email it to <u>edenswayfarmsanctuary@gmail.com</u>. You are also welcome to email this address with any questions you have about volunteering. Upon your request, a copy of the volunteer job description that you are interested in can also be forwarded to you.

Once your application is received, you will be contacted as soon as possible to schedule a phone, Zoom, or on-site meeting with the founder/Executive Director (ED) of Eden's Way Farm Sanctuary (Jaye Dueck) to go over your application, to provide more information about the volunteer position(s) you are interested in, answer any questions you have, and discuss the next steps. Please note that submitting this application form does not automatically register you as a volunteer and there is no commitment required from you at this point. After meeting with you, and it looks like our volunteer program will be a good fit for you, and you are interested in continuing the process, we will ask you to then review and sign the necessary additional paperwork (the Liability Waiver Form, Confidentiality Agreement, Volunteer Program Policies and Procedures Handbook, and Volunteer Agreement Form) and arrange an orientation to the volunteer position you will be doing (this will vary depending on whether you are volunteering on a one-time or regular basis). Some regular positions will require additional shadowing and training.

Please note that the need for volunteers will vary through the year and a limited number of positions may be available at times and thus not necessarily be able to accommodate all volunteer requests. However, upon your request, your name will be put on a wait-list and you will be notified as soon as a position and/or shift comes available.
